

JDRC Scholarship Application *Due May 9, 2019*

JDRC distributes scholarships for the purpose of encouraging Arlington High School graduates to seek post-secondary education. The information obtained in these applications will determine the recipients of those scholarships.

Recipients of awards:

- Must be enrolled as a **full-time student** in an accredited program (college/trade school) *unless* written explanation is provided.
- **Provide proof of full-time status** at the time award funds are requested.
- **Acknowledge** the sponsor(s) of a scholarship prior to receiving the funds-**thank you note**.

Students may receive a maximum of four award years from JDRC Scholarship. Applicants entering their first year of post-secondary education (college/trade school) must submit a copy of high school transcript. Applicants entering their second or subsequent year of post-secondary education must submit a copy of all college/school transcript(s) for the previous school year(s) and/or from the last school(s) attended.

JDRC reserves the right to consider only those applications found to be **complete** and **received by the application deadline**.

Minimum cumulative GPA of 1.0

Application completed and accompanied by transcript(s) and turned in by deadline
